

PHCA PIONEER HIGHLANDS PARK REGULATIONS

ALL PARK REGULATIONS ARE ENFORCED BY PHCA.

Members may invite up a small number of guests and must remain present on park property with visitors.

All children under 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult.

Small celebrations with more than 5 guests at the park require written correspondence and approval from the Board of Directors.

The rules of the Pioneer Highlands private residential park are as follows:

- A. Members are required to comply with all signage posted at the park.
- B. No pets are allowed on the park's grounds.
- C. Park hours are from dawn (sunrise) to dusk (sunset). Residents who do not abide by these hours will face legal implications.
- D. Children must be under adult supervision.
- E. No consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages in the park.
- F. No possession or use of glass products in the park.
- G. No unauthorized motorized vehicles.
- H. No damage or defacing of park property.
- I. No disruptive behavior that may disturb the peace and enjoyment of others.
- J. No littering.
- K. Members should dispose of trash in designated bins and maintain cleanliness.
- L. Smoking is prohibited within the park.
- M. Use of fireworks or any other hazardous materials is strictly prohibited.
- N. Members must respect and protect the natural habitat within the park.
